- 1. Length of Match:
  - b. 2 halves of 22 minutes each
    - There will be a 3-minute break at halftime.
      - o Teams will change ends at halftime.
    - There will be no overtime played.

#### 2. Officiating:

- e. All fouls will be enforced by referees in accordance with IFAB Laws of the game except for:

- f. Number of Players on the Field:
  - 7 with a minimum of 5 Girls
  - 9 with a minimum of 7 Boys
- g. Equipment:

- h. Build Out Lines will be located in the area halfway between the center line and the penalty area. The Build out line will be identified by a broken (dashed) paint line or another player safe manner. The build out line promotes playing the ball out of the back in a less pressured setting. When the goalkeeper has the ball, either during play (from the opponent) or from a goal kick, the opposing team must move behind the build out line until the ball is put into play. Once the opposing team is behind the build out line, the goalkeeper can pass, throw or roll the ball into play (punting/drop kicking is not allowed). After the ball is put into play by the goalkeeper and touched by a attacking player, the opposing team can cross the build out line and play resumes as normal.

a. Note: The build out line will also be used to denote where offside offenses can be called. Players cannot be penalized for an offside offense between the halfway line and the build-out line. Players can be penalized for an offside offense between the build out line and goal line in effect.

#### 3. Scheduling:

- c. The Home Team is listed first on the schedule.
- d. <u>Game Time is Forfeit Time</u>. Forfeits are defined as a team not being represented by <u>enough players</u> to reach the minimum of five (5) players.
- e. If a team cannot play six (6) on the field, then that team may play with the minimum number for this age group five (5). The opposing coach will be able to play one (1) player up if the other team cannot field the maximum number of players.
